**6:15 am Sunrise Bird Tour**— Get up before the birds! Join an expert guide from the Loess Hills Audubon Society to watch waterfowl wake-up and continue their migration. **11:00 Bird Critter Corner**— Learn about a variety of bird species in the display wing of the Education Center. Participants will be able to touch and feel talons, feathers, and beaks. A live African Ring Neck Dove will be present for the kids to see! **Meet in the display wing of the Resource and Education Center. Free.**



**2:00pm Bird Feeders** — Bird migration is in full swing and unique birds will start stopping at your feeders. Learn different tips about filling and caring for your birdfeeders. We will also be creating bird feeders. This program is for all ages. **Meet in the Resource and Education Center. \$1 per bird feeder.**



**6:00 pm– Sunset Bird Tour**— Watch the birds return to the safety of the marsh at dusk. A guide from the Loess Hill Audubon Society will accompany you to our bird blinds.
