



Ponca State Park Wildflower Week June 6—June 12, 2016



Monday, June 6

9:00 am – 11:00 am Introduction to Archery and Shotguns —Introductory courses on Archery and Shotguns will take place at the Eric Wiebe Shooting Complex. Participants are not required to attend both events. All equipment is provided. Archery participants must be 5 years old or older and shotgun participants must be 12 years old or older. **Meet and pay at each range located in the shooting complex. Cost \$1/6 arrows for archery; \$7/box of shotgun shells.**



1:00 pm Plants and Pollinators — Plants need pollinators and pollinators need plants. Improve your knowledge about this incredible topic as we visit our pollinator garden and view pollinators in action. **Meet in the Resource and Education Center. Free.**

3:00 pm Nature Collage — Nature is full of all different shapes, colors, and sizes. Join a naturalist as we learn how nature works together to make a complete picture. Participants will also be creating their own nature collage to take home. **Meet in the Resource and Education Center. Cost \$1 per craft.**

Tuesday, June 7

9:00 am — 11:00 pm Introduction to Pellet Rifles — Join us for an introductory course on pellet rifles. Participants must be 8 years of age or older to participate. All equipment is provided. **Meet and pay at Eric Wiebe Shooting Complex. Cost is \$1/4 clips.**

1:00 pm Wildflower and Watercolors — Wildflowers are so beautiful. Would you like to keep them forever? You can. Once we go through a few simple steps, you will be painting all kinds of amazing wildflowers. **Meet at the Resource and Education Center. Cost \$1 per painting.**

3:00 pm Plant Anatomy— Participants will learn the primary parts of a flower, and how each serves a key function. Also we will learn the importance of pollinators, and how pollination occurs! **Meet at the Resource and Education Center. Free.**

9:00 am — 11:00 am Introduction to Pellet Rifles and .22 Rifles — Join us for an introductory course on pellet rifles and .22 rifles. Pellet rifles participants must be at least 8 years of age, and .22 rifle participants must be at least 12 years to participate. All equipment is provided. **Meet and pay at each range located in the shooting complex. Cost is \$1/4 pellet rifle clips and \$3/ 10 rounds of .22 bullets.**

1:00 pm Education Trail Scavenger Hunt—Hike with a naturalist and use a keen eye to complete a scavenger hunt along the way. Learn some of the common wildflowers, bugs, and tracks at Ponca State Park. Complete your scavenger hunt and receive a prize. **Meet at the Resource and Education Center. Free.**

3:00 pm Wildflower Petal Beads — In the past, wildflower petal beads were cherished remembrances of the blossoms in a grandmother's garden or a bride's bouquet. Learn an easy way to make beads from petals. **Meet at the Resource and Education Center. Cost \$1 per craft.**
