Free Fishing and Park Entry Day is held annually in Nebraska's State Parks. It means anyone can fish without a permit or visit a state park area without a park entry permit that day only. Even though fishing and park entry permits are not required, anglers must observe all fishing regulations. The **Bill Morris Memorial Fishing Derby** is also a great opportunity to participate in the *Take 'em Fishing* challenge, in which anglers pledge to take new or inexperienced anglers fishing.

10:00am-11:00am Pond Macroinvertebrates - We all know there are fish in the pond, but what do the fish feed on? Join a naturalist for water quality measurements and to see if you can catch and identify the small creatures that live in the pond. *Meet at the Elk Cabin Pond Area*. Free.

1:30pm-2:15pm Make your own Fishing Lure - Colors, shapes, and sizes react differently under water. Learn how lures work to catch different species of fish. We'll make our own lures out of every day materials. Pre-register and pay at the Resource & Education Center 8:00am-1:00pm. Recommended for ages 6+ with adult supervision. Meet behind the Resource & Education Center. Cost: \$2/kit.
