Decorating contest: Decorate your campsite in preparations for the trick-or-treaters! Prizes will be given out to the top 6 places.

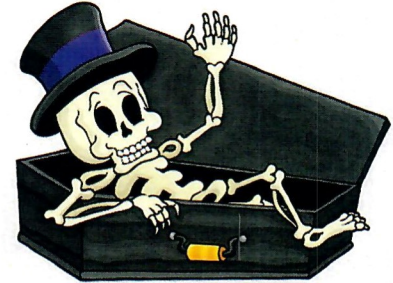
6:30 – 9:00 p.m. Trick-or-treat the campers! Campers participating will display a trick or treat ghost on their campsite post. This event is open to the public.
